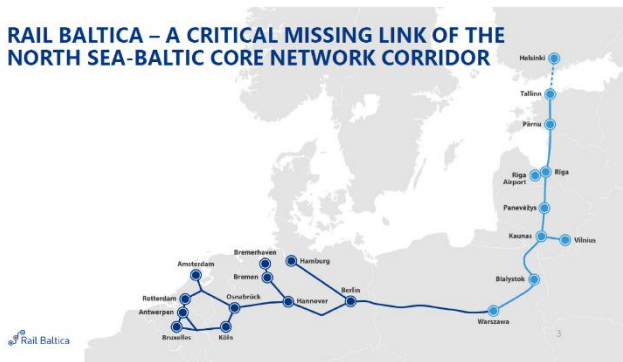

BACKGROUND

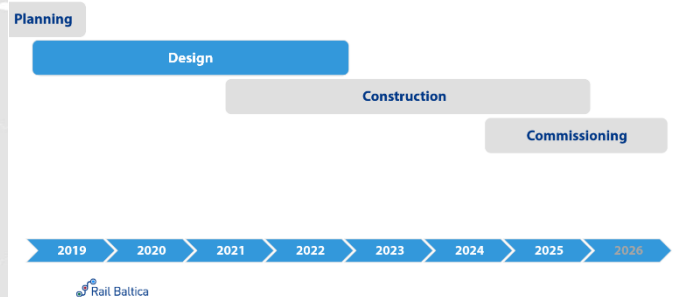
Rail Baltica is a greenfield rail transport infrastructure project with a goal to integrate the Baltic States in the European rail network. The project includes five European Union countries – Poland, Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia and also Finland. It will connect Helsinki, Tallinn, Pärnu, Riga, Panevežys, Kaunas, Vilnius, Warsaw. The Baltic part of the Rail Baltica project is referred to as the Rail Baltica Global Project.

- The largest Baltic-region infrastructure project in the last 100 years
- For both passenger and freight traffic
- Length: 870 km
- Environmentally friendly – powered by electricity, produces less noise and vibration
- Max. speed: 249 km/h (passengers), 120 km/h (freight)
- More than €5 bn investment in the region
- Implemented by Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania
- Part of the EU's North Sea Baltic TEN-T corridor
- Financed by EU (CEF), Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania
